Leo Burnett retains Creative Agency of the Year title

VML, FCB Group are placed second and third, respectively

ON THE FINAL day of the Abbys, Leo Burnett walked away as the biggest winner after picking up the Creative Agency of the Year title for the second year in a row. The agency took home a haul of 24 metals on the last day, including one Grand Prix and four gold. At number two on the list with 20 metals was VML India, followed by FCB Group India with a tally of 13 metals.

Leo Burnett was also named the Branded Content and Entertainment Specialist as well as the Brand Activation and Promotion Specialist. With 26 metals on day two, Leo Burnett's total Abbys haul was an impressive 50.

The other big winners were Havas Worldwide India, which was named Health Specialist Agency of the Year with three metals and Good Morning Films, which picked up the Video Craft Company of the Year with a total of eight metals.

which picked up a Grand Prix for its 'Feel the Music with Shankar-Ehsaan-Loy' campaign for Spotify, two other agencies picked up a Grand Prix each. Famous Innovations picked up the award for its OOH campaign 'Blockbuster Excuses for the Mumbai Police' and Maitri Advertising Works won the top honour for its work on 'Netflix's Sex Education: Sha-

keela's Driving School'. Ajay Kakar, chairperson of Awards Governing Council Abby Awards 2024 observed that the days of super specialisation in advertising were over.

"Creative agencies have picked up awards in non-specialisation categories like PR and brand activation," he said.

Day three of the Abby's saw awards across 16 categories such as diversity, equality and inclusion, cinema, the Young Maverick Abby Award and more.

Creative industry must turn brand builders: Leaders

WITH THE ADVERTISING landscape changing as quickly as it is, the need for creative agencies to position themselves as true brand builders is more urgent than ever today. Moreover, with a plethora of career options available to young talent, how can advertising agencies make themselves attractive to Gen Z?

These were some of the talk points raised on day three of the Goafest by a panel of agency leaders including Anusha Shetty, chairperson & group CEO, Grey Group India; Jitender Dabas, COO and chief strategy officer of McCann World Group India and Babita Baruah, CEO of VML India. The panel, which was moderated by Dheeraj Sinha, group CEO, India and South Asia, FCB Group India examined ways in which advertising can attract and retain young talent in the business.

VML India's Baruah, who

currently helms the newly merged entity of Wunderman Thompson and VMLY&R, stressed the need to define the organisational culture that can allow young talent to take pride in their work and workplace.

The other big discussion point was the longstanding debate on agency remuneration. Shetty observed that the advertising business is becoming too transactional because clients are demanding a quicker turnaround for deliverables and agencies are willing to meet impossible timelines without a fight, thus undermining their work in the process.

McCann's Dabas argued that this being an industry with low entry barriers, it is incumbent upon creative leaders to ensure that the price of creativity is not allowed to fall. Sinha closed the panel discussion by saying it is time for the industry to stop viewing itself as a cost but rather as a partner that adds value to brands.

How visits to Barbados helped Jofra Archer make a comeback for England

LAST WEEK TEARWAY quick Jofra Archer dismissed Pakistan's Azam Khan with his first delivery on return to international cricket after over a year. Chris Jordan, a fellow Barbadian who also plays for England, said he got goosebumps on the field. A 145kmph delivery first up in the T20 International was the perfect way for Archer to announce his return after struggling for three years to find form. Following two stress fractures of the elbow, a stress fracture of the back and two surgeries, Archer was bowling at a scorching pace with the T20 World Cup just around the corner.

"For him to get the first one out the way, it gives goosebumps to see him take that wicket. He's phenomenal. To be out of international cricket for so long, to touch 90mph and just look like he never left is awesome. And he will keep getting better with games," Jordan said.

At one point it seemed like Archer could have already played his last game for England but the wonderfully gifted Barbados-born fast bowler with a smooth action, lethal short ball, a vicious yorker and scary pace is again making life difficult for batsmen.

In the second T20 International versus Pakistan on Thursday, Archer got rid of skipper Babar Azam just as he was starting to play with freedom. Some of his deliveries were again clocked upwards of 145kmph.

The first sign of Archer cranking up the pace during the comeback trail was spotted by his mentor at Wildey Cricket Club in Barbados, home where Archer's heart lies. To break the monotony during rehabilitation in England, Archer made to and fro trips. Archer's mentor Roddy Estwick who played

for Barbados in the heydays of West Indies cricket in the 1980s talks about how the 29-year-old bowled the relegation-threatened club side to victory in December.

"I could see him enter a state where he was at peace. And in one of the net sessions, after having bowled medium-pace for a while, I could see him cranking up pace. Batsmen were suddenly not willing to face him. The confidence was growing," Estwick tells IE.

And then came the bouncer, which Australia Test great Steve Smith once described as 'felt like drinking a dozen beers' after getting hit on his helmet. "The bouncer, which is hard to pick, was being delivered effortlessly in the nets. The pace was increasing by the day. So

this comeback doesn't surprise me one bit," Estwick says.

Homecoming match

While Archer's long-awaited comeback for England is well on course, the whole of Barbados is waiting for his homecoming. Not everyone was pleased with Archer's decision to move to the UK and represent England but as he made a mark in international cricket, the sentiment changed.

Since leaving the island, Archer hasn't played a competitive fixture in Barbados. On June 4, when England play Scotland, Archer would get a chance to play at Bridgetown, in familiar surroundings. "I've been praying all along to see him play at Bridgetown. He has chosen England, but he is one of our own."

Growing link between creativity & ad effectiveness, say experts

RESEARCH SAYS THAT over 41% of advertising spending goes to waste as ad campaigns fail to deliver on their objectives and return on investment. As advertiser focus increasingly grows on reducing wastage, not just in India but across the world, attention is shifting to improving ad effectiveness.

In a masterclass on the 'Anatomy of Effectiveness' on Friday at the Goafest 2024 in Mumbai, global marketing insights and intelligence firm Warc noted that there are five building blocks of effectiveness. This includes investing

for growth, balancing spending, planning for reach, being creative and nurturing distinctive assets for quick recognition.

Warc's global advisory consultant Sujet Kulkarni said that prioritising penetration, focussing on future demand, and ensuring that there is channel synergy in a fragmented media world could go a long way to improve ad effectiveness.

"If your ad campaigns can appeal to the right-side brain, which is more visual, intuitive, and creative than the left-side brain, which is more rational, it can help elicit an emotional response and drive mental availability.

This can drive greater campaign performance," he said. Kulkarni also highlighted that there was a growing link between creativity and advertising effectiveness.

"Creativity is the most powerful weapon under a marketer's control. Look for creative ideas that have an emotional appeal or use humour to supercharge your campaign," he said.

Women identity & ad impact taken up

ADVERTISING HAS THE power to shape how we see each other, and the representation of women in advertising has been a subject of much debate and scrutiny over the years.

In a session on 'Indian Women Harnessing the Power of Identity' on Friday at the Goafest 2024 in Mumbai, Shilpa Rao, a playback singer, filmmaker Alankrita Shrivastava, actor Tamannaah Bhatia, and content creator, actor, and climate activist Prajakta Koli delved into the world of how women are viewed in popular culture and how digital media is significantly changing the

idea of identity and self-perception for many.

Bhatia, a popular actor who has worked in the Tamil, Telugu, and Hindi film industries, noted that she did not confine herself to a specific medium or language.

"I did not let my thoughts and opinions get in the way of my work or who I am as an individual. I want to be the medium in whichever language, and I find a lot of strength in that surrender to the craft," she said.

She emphasised the importance of versatility and openness in her career. The session was moderated by Ambika Muttoo, editor-in-chief of Femina magazine.
